Greetings to you all, from Fr. Saji Thomas, the priest responsible for the above said project. With immense joy and happiness I write this thanking letter because you have done great things for me and for the people of this area in helping me to construct the extension of this school at Mronggre.

I remember with gratitude Manos Unidas who had been instrumental in helping us to construct the first phase. And when the children are more in the school, and the space was not enough to contain the children I had asked for the extension and you have to come to our help through CIUDAD REAL.

You know for certain that the people whom we serve are tribal, and they are very poor. Mronggre is very much a backward area and there were no education possibilities for these people. Practically speaking there are no educated people in this area. And after once we have started with our school, the education scenario is improved and there are people who are availing the possibility for good education.

Now at present there are around 500 children studying in our school both boys and girls almost in the same proportion. We have a committed group of teachers who teach them and looking at the all round development of the children. The basic thing was the school building and its extension. And I should say that you really deserve the thanks from our part.

I Fr. Saji Thomas in the name of the school and of the people of this area thank you very much for the help you had extended in for the extension work of the school at Mronggre. For the generosity which you had shown we will ever remain thankful to you and the children who are profiting out of this school will be the fruit of your sacrifice.
